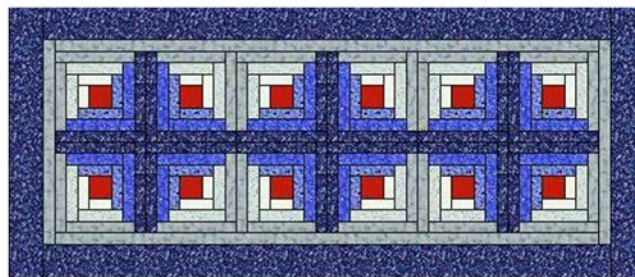
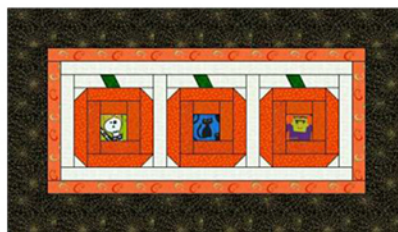


Build a Log Cabin Quilt



Create a classic quilt using the Log Cabin quilt block. The Log Cabin block became popular in the 1860's, and remains a beloved pattern today. Learn how to construct the traditional Log Cabin block and use it to create a table runner or wall hanging, or add blocks for a larger quilt. In class you will learn to accurately piece this block using various techniques, including paper-piecing, and how to finish your quilt with borders and binding. See how different color values create different visual effects, and explore variations of the block. Choose one of three projects, using your favorite colors or a holiday theme. Your quilt will make a perfect addition to your home.
