



Flower Pounding



A Springtime Art

Turn fabric and nature into art with flower pounding – the simple and traditional technique of transferring flower and leaf pigment to paper or a prepared fabric surface using a hammer. In this class you will experiment with fresh flowers, leaves and grasses on muslin and paper, then work on a final nature-inspired design. You may choose to further enhance your piece with embroidery thread, beading, or other forms of embellishment. Your finished artwork can then be used in a quilt, a table runner, wall hanging, decorative pillow, or as an art piece displayed in a frame. Other possible projects include greeting cards, gift tags or gift bags, collage, potpourri bags, or a handmade journal.

Prepared for Dyeing (PFD) fabric will be supplied.
